## Project Award

In 2009, the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUCT) selected Cross Texas Transmission to construct, operate, and maintain over 200 miles of transmission lines and associated equipment as part of an ~\$4.9 billion in new electric transmission infrastructure to deliver renewable energy from competitive renewable-energy zones (CREZs) to electric customers in Texas.

## Assets

- Represents a build-out of 261 miles of transmission lines across the Texas Panhandle region
- Four substations energized, including Cross, Gray, Railhead, and Allen Creek



## Project Highlights

### Under Budget & Ahead of Schedule

Cross Texas Transmission delivered its assets on-time and on-budget.

### Regional Development

The transmission infrastructure improvements that are part of the CREZ plan consist of more than 2,300 miles of new high-voltage transmission lines designed to increase the system capacity to accommodate 18,456 megawatts of renewable energy.
